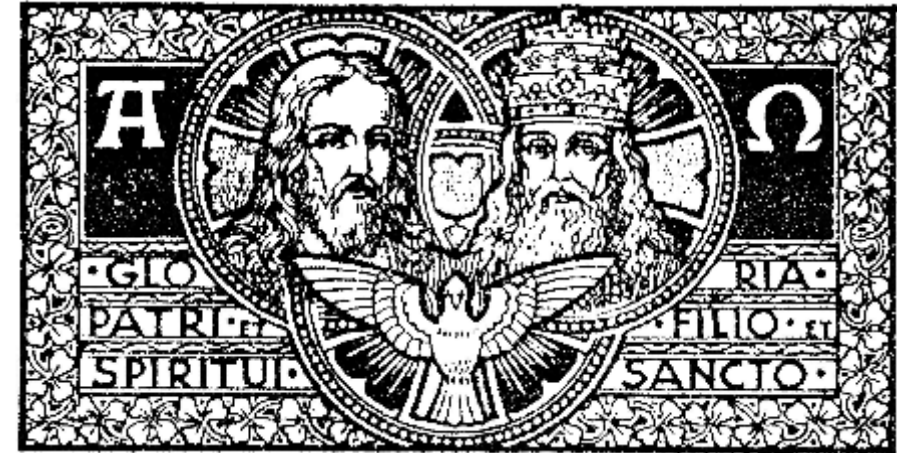
Our next monthly potluck social will be held on July 2nd after Mass in the Msgr. Thomas H. Smith Social Hall.
