



### **Main Goals**

1. A strategic planning meeting with the Vicar General to discuss the place of the Lancaster Latin Mass Community among the current diocesan Traditional communities (FSSP, Carmelite Sisters, Hermits) and how that fits within the larger diocesan pastoral plan. This meeting would help establish a time-line for stabilization to include discussion of clergy and location long-term.
2. A canonically-appointed Chaplain for the Lancaster Latin Mass Community is still a goal nearly 12 years into our existence. Our community lacks stability without formal canonical recognition and without formal clergy appointment. As Bishop Gainer's retirement draws closer in August 2022, this issue will become a more pressing concern. In the short-term, Fr. Olkowski has only 18 months left (officially) before he completes his assignment which creates growing anxiety among the faithful.
3. A Sunday morning Mass time prior to 12 noon.

### **Secondary Goals**

1. **Easter Morning Mass** similar to the Christmas Day schedule.
2. **St. Joseph Guild** - a monthly evening Mass for men who can never attend the 8 am. low Mass due to work obligations.
3. **Pontifical Mass** offered by Bishop Schneider in October 2020.
4. **First Saturdays** with Fr. Arena or another priest who wants to learn.

6. Establishment of a formal **Juventutem** Chapter for the Young Adult Group
7. Establishment of an **Una Voce** Chapter
